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## General Settings

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On the **General** settings page of an access point, you can edit the IP settings.

Complete the following steps to edit the IP settings of an AP.

1. On the navigation bar, click **Wi-Fi** > (and then) **Access Points** > (and then) **Access Point List**.  
The **Wi-Fi** page is displayed.
2. Click the name of the AP to edit the IP settings.
3. On the upper-right corner, click **Configure**.  
The AP configuration page is displayed.

4. (Optional) Edit the AP name, description, tags, and GPS coordinates.

**Note:**

The GPS settings must correspond to the venue's country. When relocating an AP, the system ensures that the GPS coordinates are consistent with the venue's country and issues a warning message `Cannot set AP GPS coordinates to a location in a different country code or country than the venue` if there is a discrepancy. This rule does not apply to APs with AFC enabled and outdoor APs that support 6GHz.

5. After editing, click **Apply**.

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
